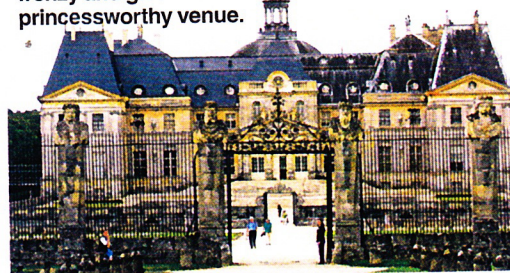
CARRIE UNDERWOOD would prefer a small wedding, but "I honestly don't think that's going to happen!" she admits.

A château in France would allow Carrie to avoid a media frenzy and give her a princessworthy venue.



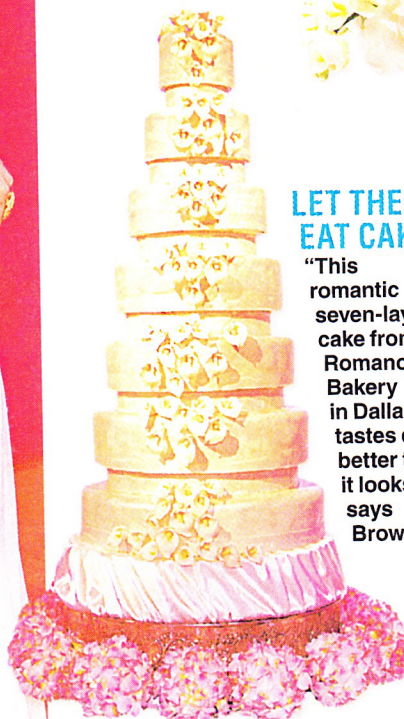
ROMANTIC ROSES

"I think she'll go for a traditional bouquet, and this one would look sublime with her flouncy gown," says Brown.



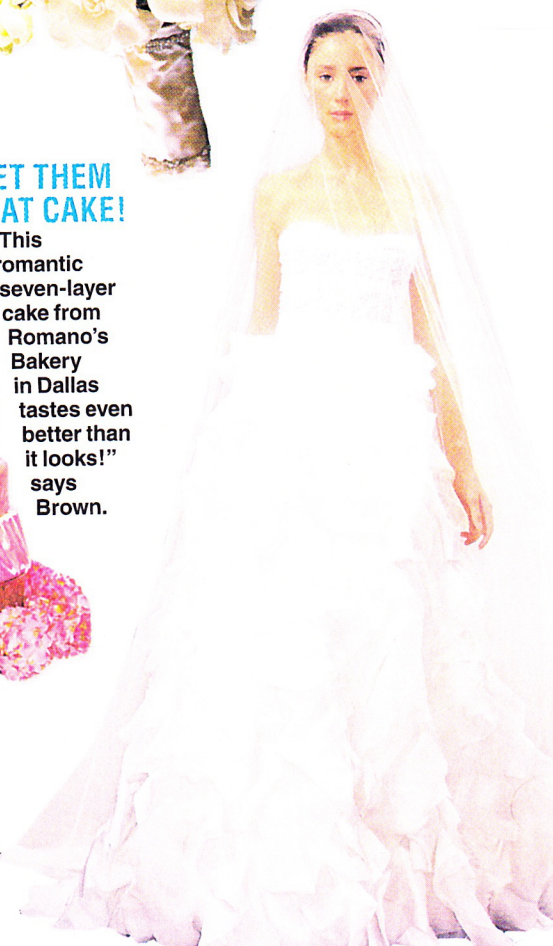
LET THEM EAT CAKE!

ROOM WITH A HUE

"I picked this space at the **SLS Hotel** in **Beverly Hills** because it's so hip and edgy."

DISTINCTIVE DRESS

GRAPHIC DESIGN

Katy could opt for unusual blooms, like these chocolate cosmos.

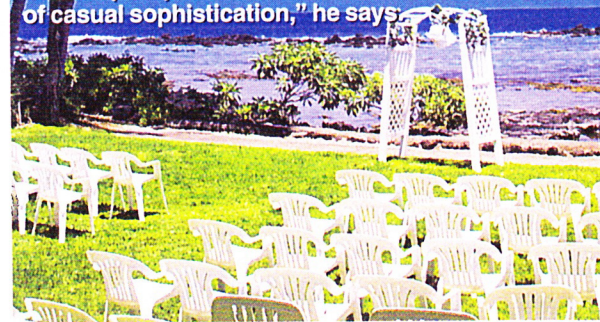


Though her mother has been bugging her, unbridezilla-esque EMILY BLUNT has yet to pick a wedding date!

RACHEL BILSON is engaged to her *Jumper* co-star HAYDEN CHRISTENSEN.

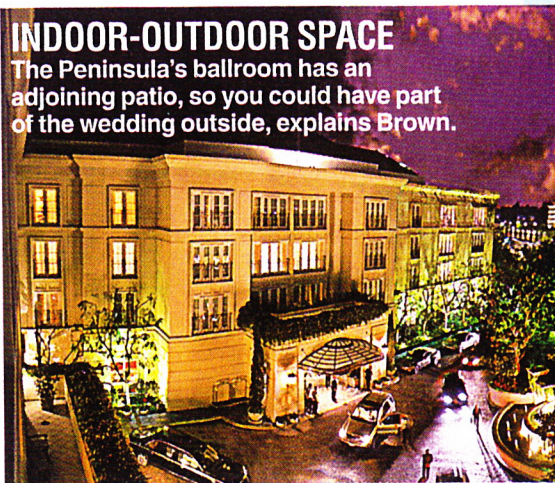


A FETE FOR A FASHIONISTA
